



GENERAL FIELD RULES

Without fields there is no league!!!

Tobacco: Absolutely no Dipping, Chewing, E-cig or Smoking Tobacco at any field at any time. No tobacco products are permitted anywhere on the premises of any school, college or city property. NO TOBACCO!

ALCOHOL: The consumption of alcoholic beverages at anytime, anywhere on the premises of any field is strictly prohibited. That means, not on the field, dugout, in the stands, in the parking lot, or the surrounding areas.
NO DRINKING!

RESTROOMS: All players must use restrooms or portable toilets. Do not urinate on the field or premises. If the facilities are locked please contact League President.

DUGOUTS: Regardless of the prior condition, you must leave dugouts clean. Clean up all trash from the dugouts before you leave. CLEAN UP THE DUGOUTS!

PREGAME: NEVER begin infield practice while the prep crew is still on the field. ALWAYS warm-up and play catch in the outfield, and NEVER play catch in front of the dugout or along baselines.

PARKING: Only park in marked parking areas. You park at your own risk! There is no insurance for the vehicles of players, umpires, score keepers, family members, friends or any other spectators. Use common sense when parking your vehicle.

Throwing Equipment: Any throwing of equipment will get you ejected from game.

No soft-toss into any fence!! Only soft-toss in designated areas where nets are available.

Home Team: Responsible for cleaning and sweeping their dugout, raking their baselines (NEVER SIDE TO SIDE), cutouts, and home plate areas. Also watering mound and plate areas.

Visiting Team: Responsible for cleaning and sweeping their dugout, raking their baselines (NEVER SIDE TO SIDE), cutouts, and pitcher's mound areas. Also tamping bullpen mound and plate areas.

Entering Field: Never enter the baseball field after a high school baseball game until both teams and coaches have departed the field.

Broken Bats: All broken bats Must be taken off school campus.
